

Powering On your new Samsung Galaxy A9 Tablet

1. **Locate the Power Button:** The power button on the Galaxy A9 tablet is located on the right side of the device when facing the screen. It's located just above the volume buttons.



2. **Press and Hold the Power Button:** Gently press and hold the power button for a few seconds. You don't need to apply much force; just a firm press will do.
3. **Wait for the Screen to Turn On:** Once you press the power button, the screen should light up within a few seconds, displaying the Samsung logo or a welcome screen.

Charging your Samsung Galaxy A9 Tablet

1. Access the Settings Menu:

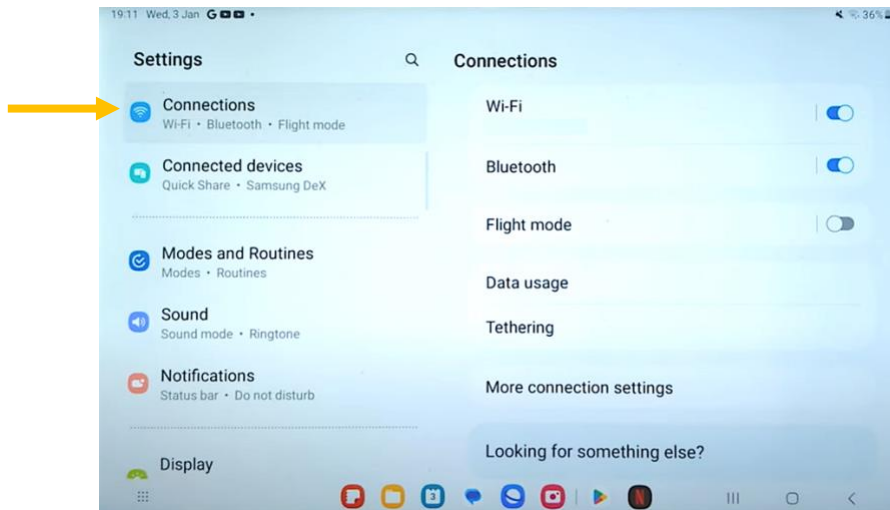
- a. From the Home screen of your Samsung Galaxy A9 tablet, swipe from the right to left to access the additional menu that includes the "Settings" icon.



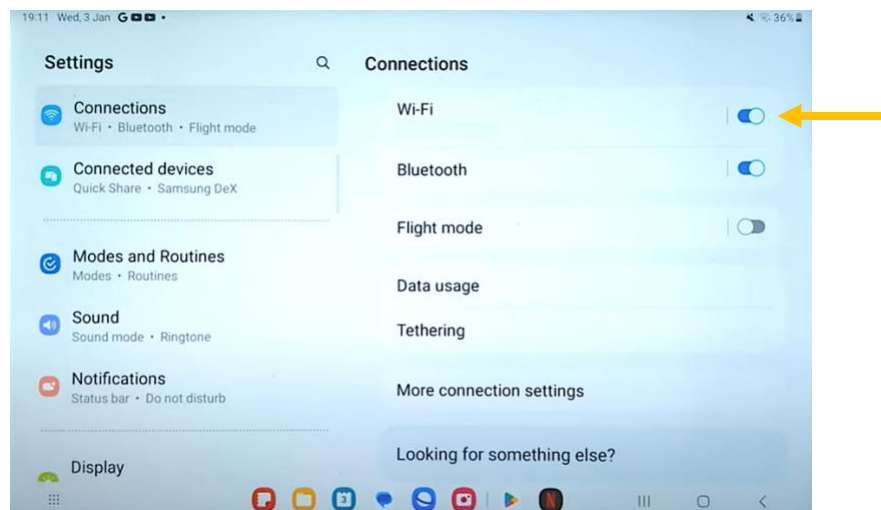
- b. Find and tap on the "Settings" icon as seen below.



2. Go to Connections Settings:
 - a. With the Settings menu open, select "Connections".



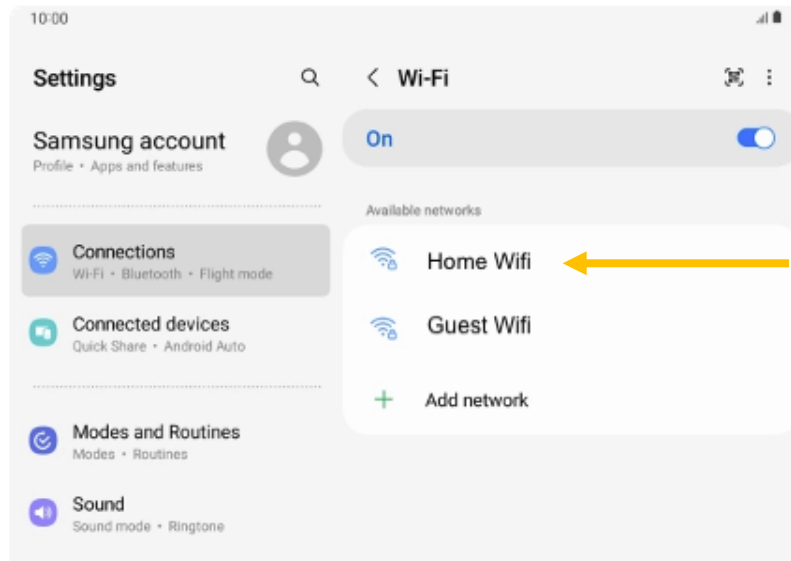
3. Select Wi-Fi:
 - a. In the Connections menu, tap on "Wi-Fi" to open Wi-Fi settings.



4. **Select a Network:**

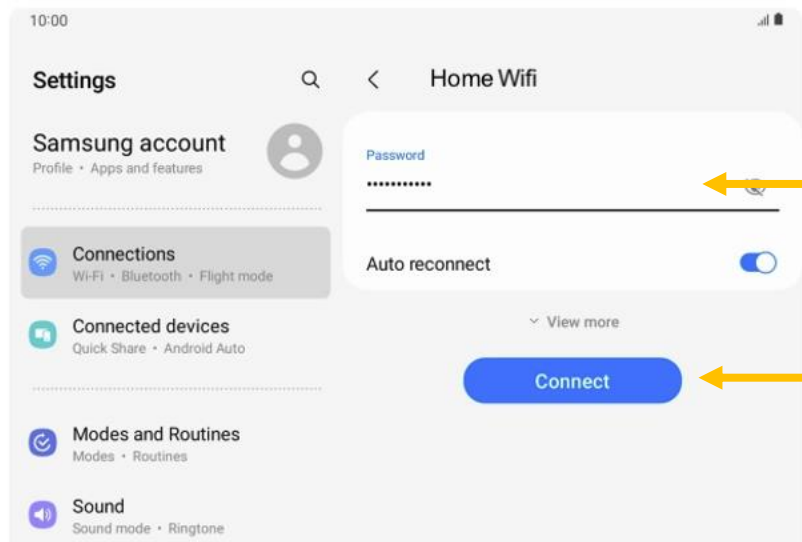
- a. Once Wi-Fi is enabled, a list of available networks will appear. Scroll through the list until you find the network you would like to connect to and tap on its name.

NOTE: "Home Wifi" is an example utilized for demonstration purposes, please look for the name of your personal wifi when connecting to your home internet.



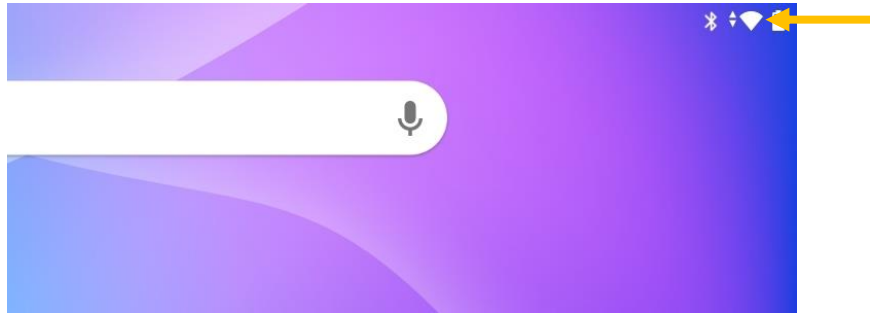
5. **Enter the Wi-Fi Password:**

- a. If the network you selected is secured, you will be prompted to enter a password. Type in the network's password and then tap "Connect".



6. **Connected to Wi-Fi:**

- a. After a moment, you should see a Wi-Fi symbol appear in the status bar at the top of your screen, indicating you are connected and ready to begin using your Age of Learning programs.
