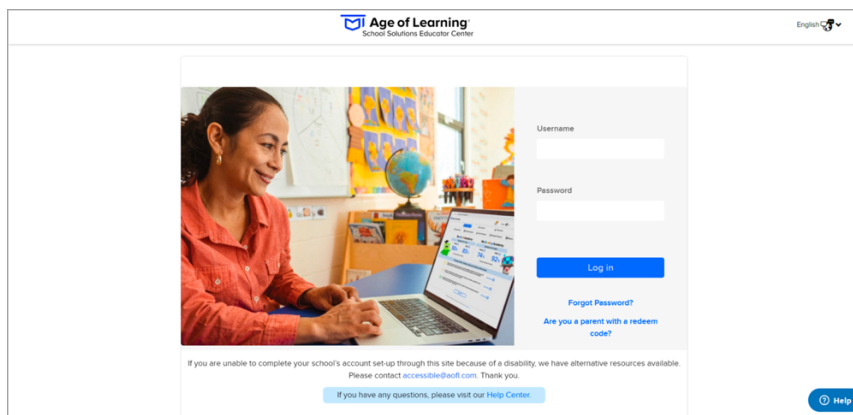


# Tracking Usage Trends for Your Class

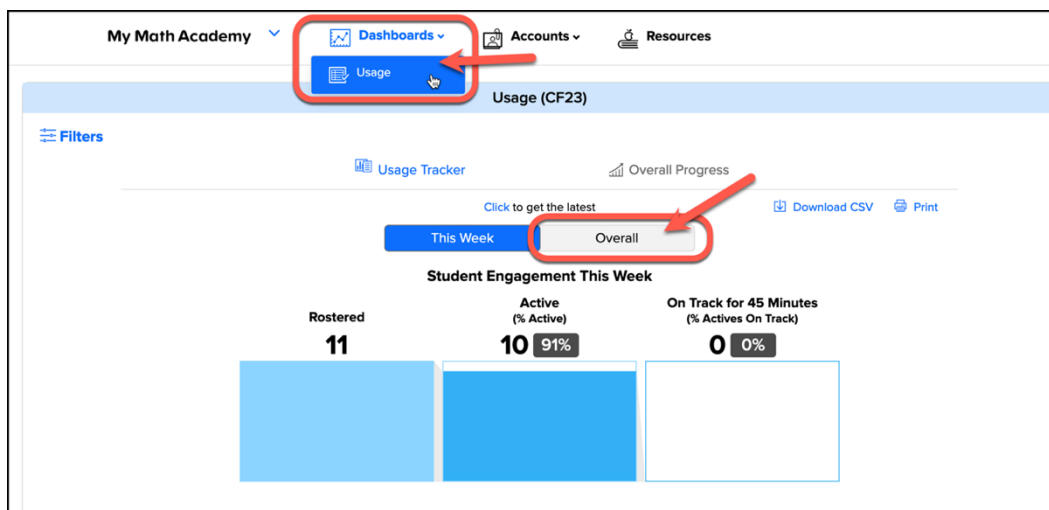
## For My Math Academy

The Educator Center **Usage Dashboards** make it simple for teachers to see whole class program usage, both for the current week and for all the previous weeks your class has been using the program.

1. Log in to your [Educator Center](#) account.



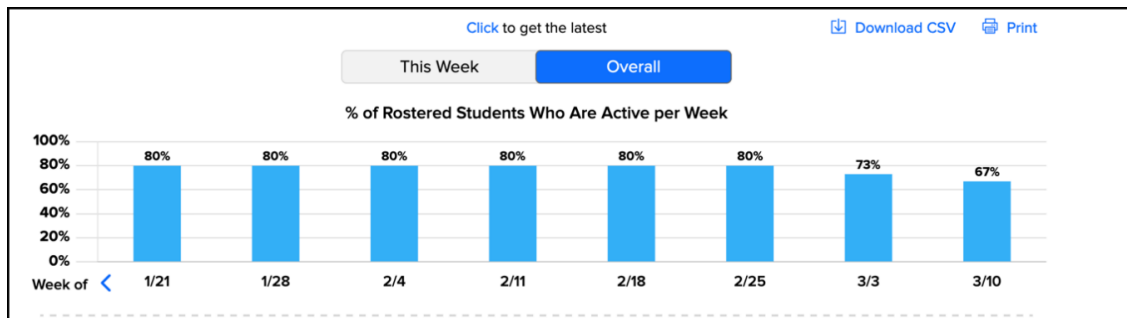
2. Click **Dashboards** at the top of your screen and select **Usage** in the drop-down. The Dashboard defaults to a view of **This Week** and gives a snapshot of usage for the current week, notably the percent of your students who have been **Active** and the percent **On Track** to meet their weekly usage goals. To see usage trends over time, click the **Overall** tab in the center of the page.



After clicking the **Overall** tab, you will see the following charts in this order:

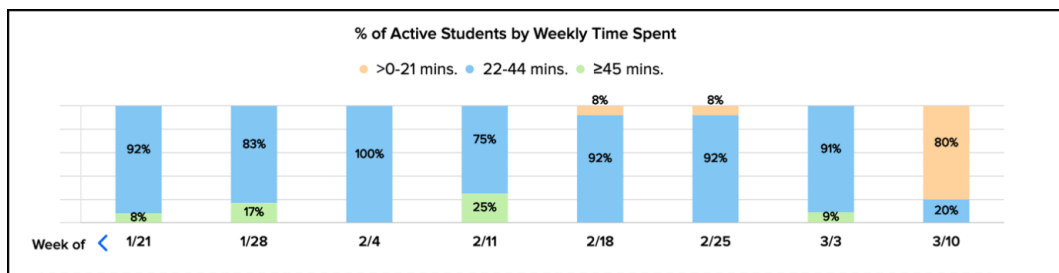
## Overall Student Usage Data

### % Of Rostered Students Who Are Active Per Week



- **What it is:** This report reveals the percentage of students from your roster who are actively engaged with the program each week.
- **Why it matters:** Understanding the percentage of active students each week helps you assess the consistency of student engagement and adjust accordingly.

### % Of Active Students by Weekly Time Spent



- **What it is:** An at-a-glance summary that identifies active students by the amount of time they spend engaging with the program each week.
- **Why it matters:** This overview helps you understand the distribution of time spent among active students, enabling you to adjust accordingly.

## Total Weekly Minutes Per Student



- **What it is:** A visual representation of the total number of minutes each student spends engaging with the program weekly.
- **Why it matters:** Analyzing the total weekly minutes per student helps recognize engagement levels.
