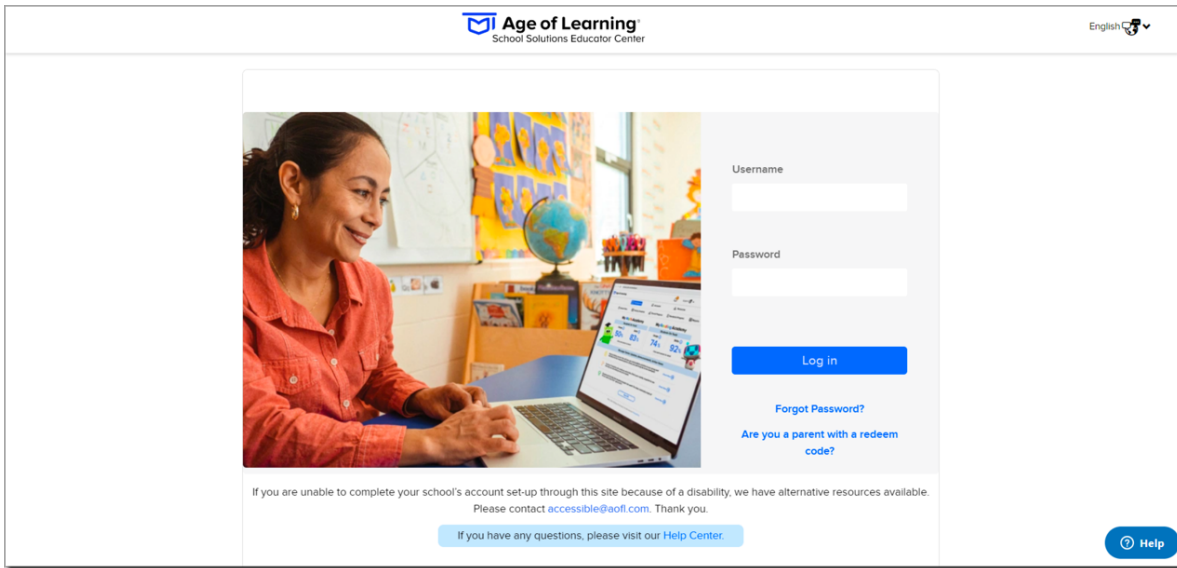


Accessing Weekly Student Usage Data

For My Math Academy

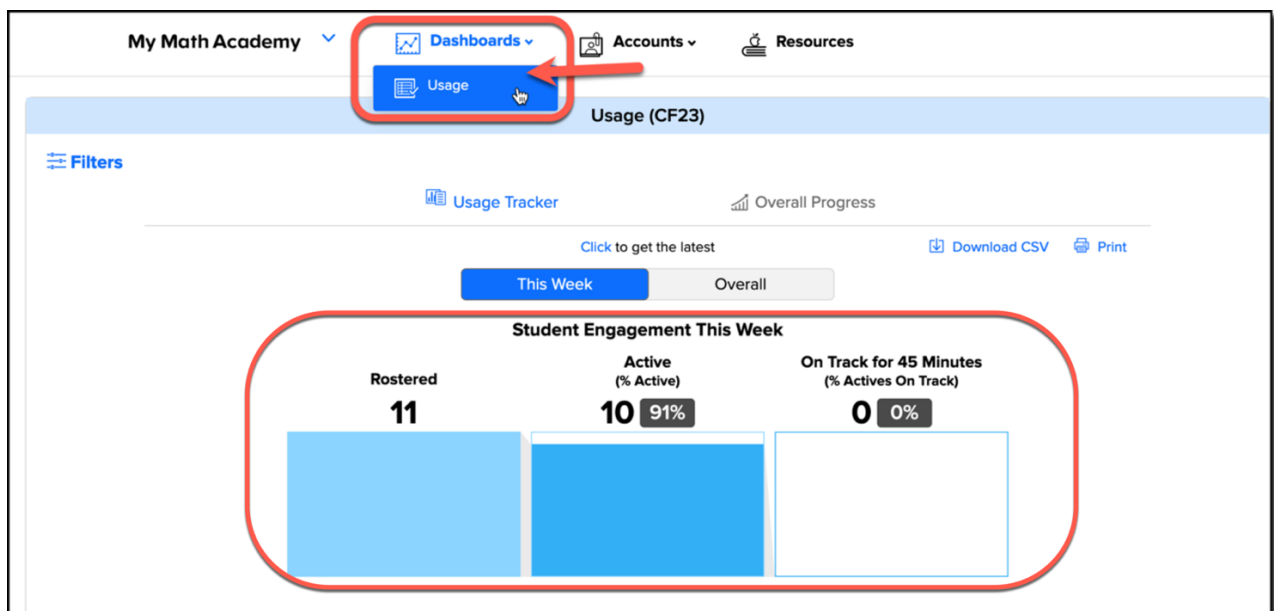
Our Educator Center's **Usage Dashboards** make it simple for teachers to find student usage data. We will guide you through all the valuable information offered.

1. Log in to your [Educator Center](#) account.



2. Click **Dashboards** at the top of your screen, then **Usage**.

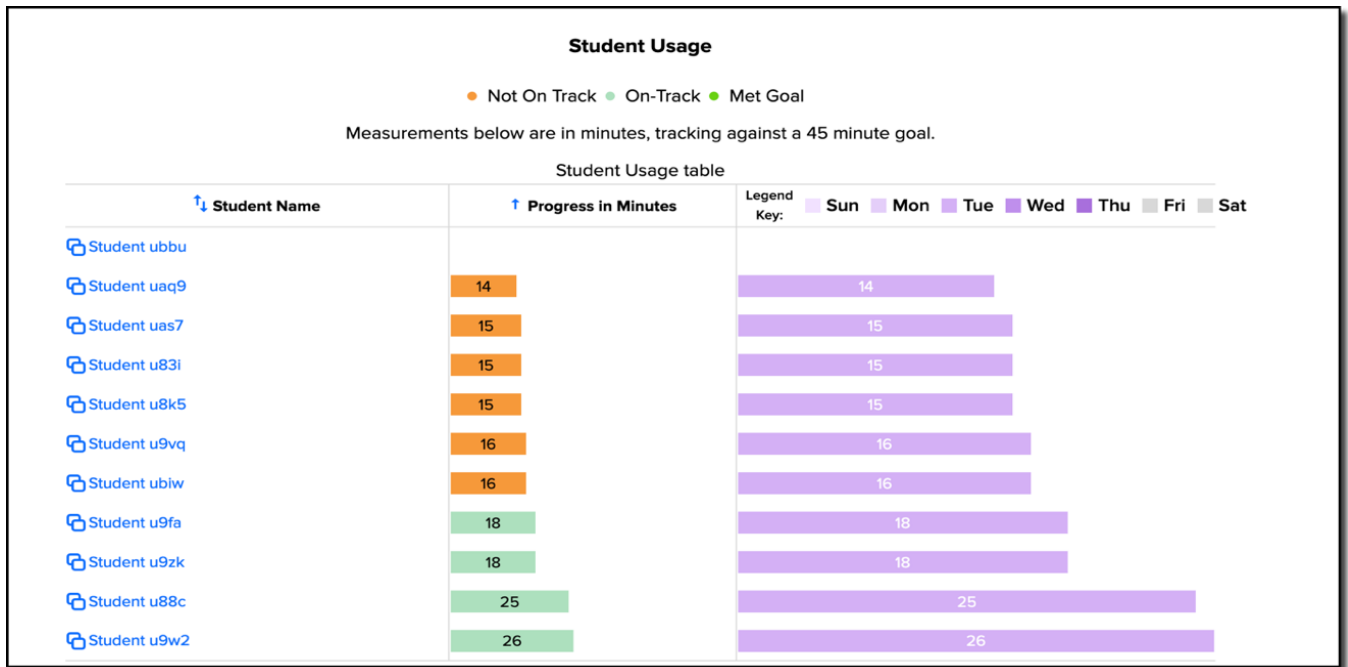
The **Student Engagement This Week** bar graphs give you a quick snapshot of **Rostered**, **Active**, and students **On Track for 45 Minutes** of usage for the current week.



Note: Usage data populates from Monday through Sunday and resets every Sunday evening. Therefore, usage will not show early Monday until students begin gameplay.

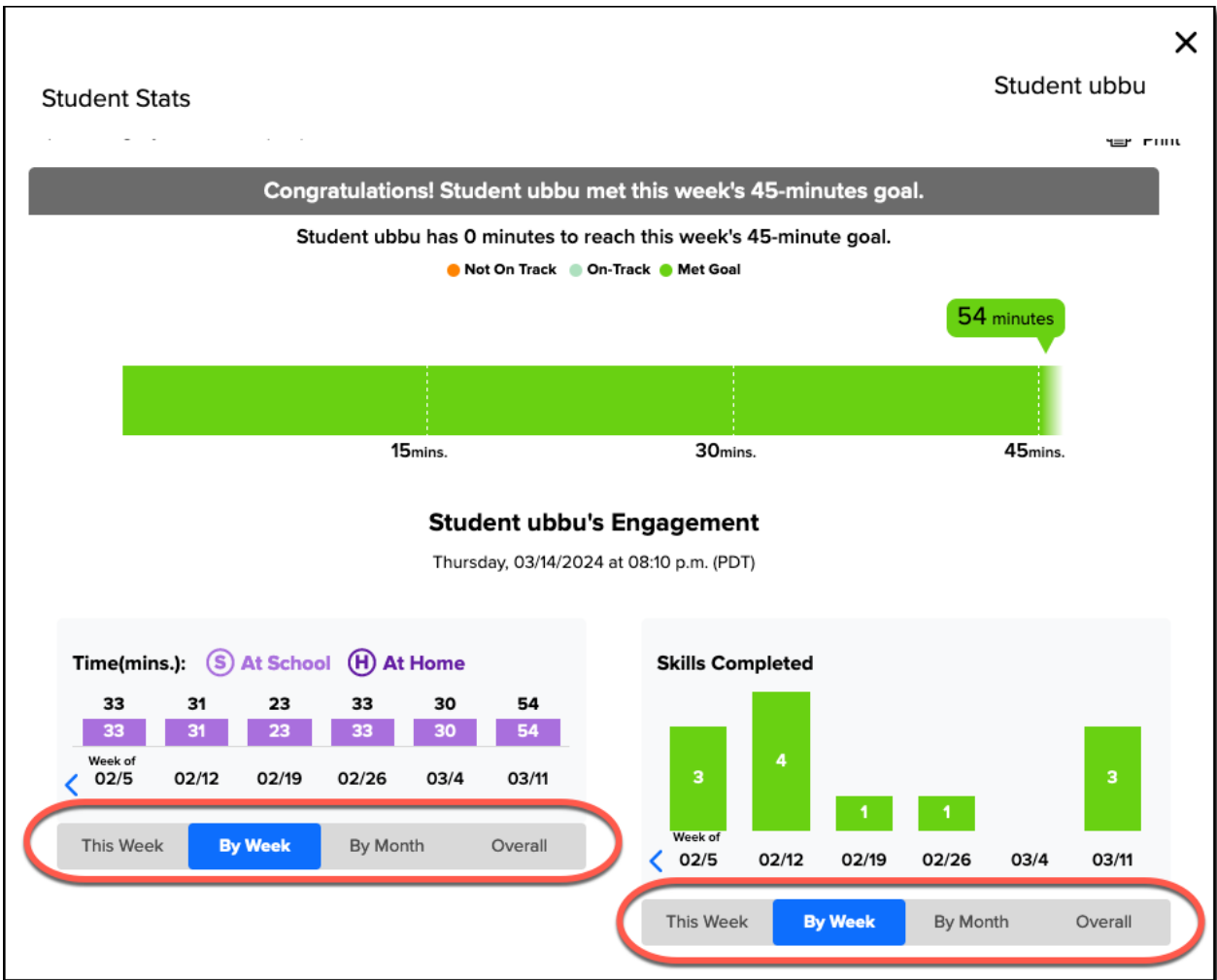
3. Scroll down to find the **Student Usage** section to see progress in minutes and if individual students are not on track, on track, or have already met their goal for **This Week**.

You can sort these graphs by student names (A-Z or Z-A) or **Progress** (least to most, most to least) by clicking on the column headers.



Note: Students with orange bars are not on track and will need additional support.

4. To learn more about student usage over time, click on any name in the **Student Usage** chart to view the following **Student Stats** page:



Note: The bar chart at the top depicts usage data for the current week. There are tabs below to view **This Week**, **By Week**, **By Month**, for **Overall** Usage and Skills completed. This chart will also identify both **At Home** and **At School** usage. Using MMA at home also counts in your usage totals and goals met.
