



Accessing Resources for Intervention or Extended Learning

For My Math Academy & My Reading Academy


1. Log in to your [Educator Center](#) account.




2. Use the drop-down menu to select the program.




3. Click **Resources** at the top of your screen.




4. Click the **Skills and Concepts** link.



5. You will see a small pop-up window with the heading **Lessons: My Math Academy** or **Lessons: My Reading Academy**, depending on the program you selected. Click the drop-down menu to select a set of standards for either **Florida's B.E.S.T.** or **Florida Early Learning and Development Standards**.



6. Click on the grade level of interest. For **B.E.S.T** standards, both programs have kindergarten, 1st grade, and 2nd grade, and *My Reading Academy* adds a small number of 3rd grade lessons. **Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards** includes Preschool and Pre-K lessons for *My Math Academy* and Pre-K lessons for *My Reading Academy*.



7. Click on the standard of interest. You will now see the specific standards strand (1), a game within the selected program that teaches this standard (2), along with a game description and why it's important, and a blue button (3) to access additional resources you can use to target this standard in your class.

8.
